#### QUARTERLY NEWSLETTER - ministry update from the Schreck family in Italy!







Greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ. As we sit down to write this newsletter we are astonished at how fast these past three months have gone by. We started the quarter coming out of another lockdown and lots of restrictions. Gradually, things have loosened up since then, and more and more we have been able to get back to the streets, be among the people, and reach the people with the Gospel of Jesus. For one week now, we have not been required to wear a mask outside. What a relief!

In April and May, unfortunately, we had a lot of rainy cold weather, and that hindered much of the evangelism. It also resulted in us having head colds and sickness. Thankfully our son was able to return to nursery school to be with other kids and continue learning Italian. He really enjoys his time there and we thank the Lord. They finished on June 30 for summer break and will restart in September, though many are now fearful of another covid wave and more lockdowns after the summer due to the "Delta variant" which apparently spreads even among the vaccinated... It's been nice for us to again be among the parents and families. Beatrice is now 8 months old. By God's grace, she's growing well. As a missionary family, the Lord is continuing to teach us how to work together as we pioneer alone in this season, paving the way for more missionaries to join in full-time for this next church plant.

We were recently, very much encouraged in our hearts to have participated virtually in the Radius International Missiology Conference. There were well-known speakers there, and yet the crowd was seemingly small. This reminded us of how few actually get involved in Jesus' global mission in a serious way. Ultimately, there is no gain to be had when getting involved in missions. It's a total sacrifice and that doesn't appeal to the flesh... # VERA VITA CHURCH PLANTING - Vera Vita Outreach Ministry

One of the blessings of participating in the 2-day missiology conference last month was the reminder of the suffering that missionaries endure to fulfill their God-given ministry. We were reminded that in certain contexts, it's not unusual that several years can go by before seeing the first converts. We're also reminded of God's sovereignty and timing; that ultimately salvation truly belongs to Him. He has the timing and His ways are not like our ways. It's the gospel alone that is the power unto salvation (Rom. 1:16), not our methods, personality, or anything else. As with Lydia in Acts 16, it is God alone who opens a heart to truly hear and receive the Gospel message we proclaim. The apostles had no control over which hearts would be opened to hear and receive the Gospel, and neither do we. We pray to the Lord, as they did, to be bold and to lovingly speak the Word faithfully (Acts 4:29).

Serving in this part of Italy, we are aware that the Lord has given us a task clearly beyond any man's natural abilities. Significantly less than 1% are evangelical. This people group is extremely secular, post-catholic, yet still very much a predominantly Roman Catholic culture. We bow down daily before Him, seek His power, and trust Him as we go and continue evangelizing the lost. May it please our Lord to transfer people from darkness to light and form for Himself a people who are not now His people.

Though we don't have our evangelism cohorts helping us this summer because of the pandemic, we are doing what we can and trusting our efforts to the Lord who alone can change the sinner's heart. We are taking the Gospel house to house, to the town square (piazza), and in the digital piazza. We're also now having people over to our home. We invite you to join us in prayer that God the Father would powerfully draw people to Himself. Potentially, we may have some helpers to join us as soon as we begin a home Bible study. (More to come on this soon). May the Lord direct our steps.
